



Planning A Trip?

Will you be traveling with your WCTFCU VISA debit card or VISA credit card? It is imperative that you speak directly with us prior to your departure, so that we may enter your travel dates and mobile phone number to ensure smooth transactions outside of your usual usage area. Giving us your mobile phone number is very important so that our Fraud Alert Department can contact you



directly, and reach you immediately, should an issue arise. To avoid the blocking or cancellation of your card, accept the Fraud Alert Department's call and provide the info they request. You may be asked to confirm the last 4 digits of your Social Security number, and/or the last 4 digits on your credit card. You will also be asked, "Did you make a purchase at XYZ retailer in the amount of \$XXX?".

Our entire membership will receive replacement VISA® Debit Cards (above left), and VISA Credit Cards (above right). These replacement Chip Cards provided at no cost to our members, deliver the best security available for debit and credit card transactions. Scholarships Awarded

WCTFCU scholarships are granted annually to 4 high school senior Members who will start college in the fall. Three \$1,000 scholarships are given to students majoring in any field of study. The Jean O'Brien Memorial Scholarship, a \$2,000 per year, 4-year scholarship is granted to a student pursuing an education major. The four 2016 scholarship winners were selected by the Board of Directors, Scholarship Committee, from among 48 applicants, based upon scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, and an essay. Lauren Reilly was awarded the four-year Jean O'Brien Memorial Scholarship. The three \$1,000 general scholarships were granted to John Swanson, Jake Rinaldi, and Kathleen Stango. Baby Bucks Winners & Program

Congratulations to little Rosalie, Henry and Tiden, our 2015 Baby Bucks winners! They were born in 2015, and their loved ones opened up a Baby Bucks Savings Account for them. Thus, their names were entered into our annual Baby Bucks raffle, from which 3 winners are pulled at random to win \$25, \$50 & \$100s. For their next smart, financial baby-steps, we suggest our Head Start Savings Account, which encourages young members to save by rewarding them with a special 5.00% interest rate on funds up to \$1,000 until the saver reaches the age of 18. Once the young member reaches the age of 18 (or when balance exceeds \$1,000) funds will earn the regular savings rate.
